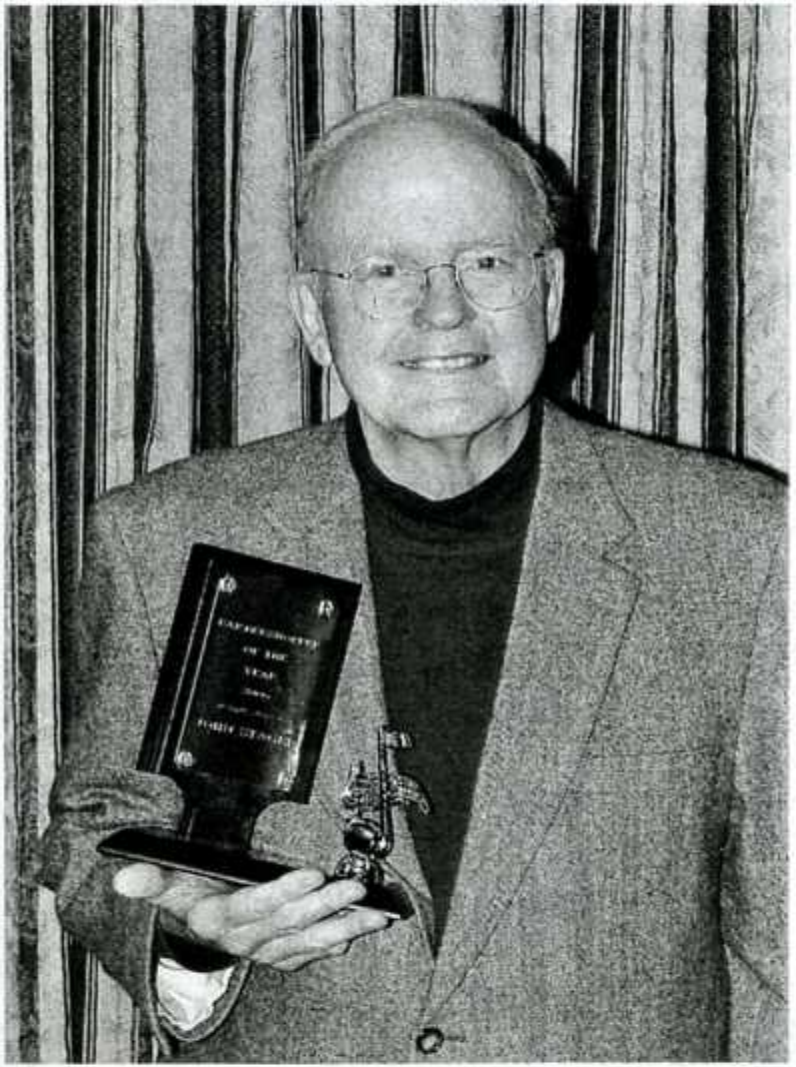

Late Fall is favored

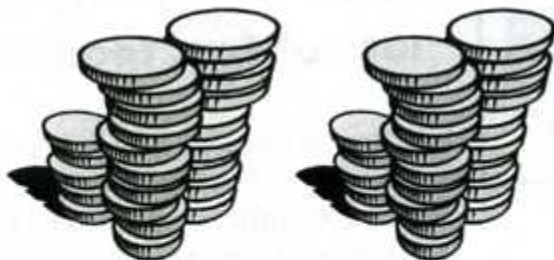

Valentine program very successful

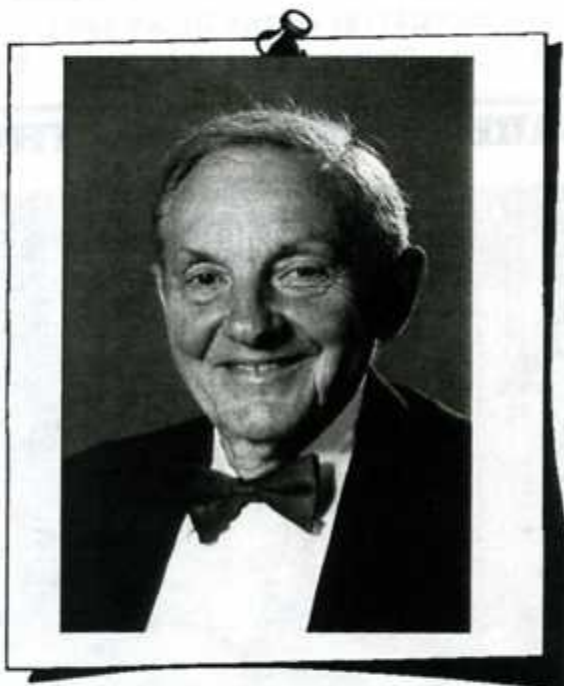
Despite the snowy weather
